

Minutes Of The Public Hearing Of The Common Council Of The City Of Chetek Held On Tuesday, February 8<sup>th</sup>, 2011 At 6:00 P.M. In The Council Chamber, Chetek City Hall, 220 Stout Street

Mayor Dianne Knowlton called the hearing to order at 6:00 p.m.

Roll Call: Cliff Bronstad, Bill Waite, Mike Linton, Dennis Morley

The purpose of the hearing is to hear citizens' comments regarding the proposed Neighborhood Preservation Ordinance developed by the Plan Commission. The common Council will act on this matter at the 7:00 p.m. meeting following this hearing.

Alan Dobrowolski asked who would handle the enforcement of this ordinance. Mayor Knowlton advised that the building inspector/zoning administrator would enforce the ordinance. He also asked what "excessive" means in terms of animal feces? What programs are available to help people that cannot afford to make improvements?

Mayor Knowlton advised that the City of Chetek has a revolving Community Development Block Grant program. Any monies available would be given priority to those who had violations. She also advised that Mr. Atwood would be working with homeowners to find solutions to get the repairs done. Homeowners would be given sufficient time to make necessary improvements.

Motion to adjourn the hearing by Linton, seconded by Bronstad. Motion carried.
